Provincial's Message

My Dear Brothers in Christ!

Greetings!

We celebrate the feast of the Immaculate Conception on 8th December every year. In Luke 1:28 the angel Gabriel, speaking on God's behalf, addresses Mary as "full of grace" or "highly favored". However, the Church grows in understanding with the help of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit led the Church, especially non-theologians, to the insight that Mary had to be the most perfect work of God next to the Incarnation. Or rather, Mary's intimate association with the Incarnation called for the special involvement of God in Mary's whole life.

The logic of piety helped God's people to believe that Mary was full of grace and free of sin from the first moment of her existence. Moreover, this great privilege of Mary is the highlight of all that God has done in Jesus. Rightly understood, the incomparable holiness of Mary shows forth the incomparable goodness of God.

In the 18th century it became a feast of the universal Church. It is now recognized as a solemnity. In 1854, Pius IX solemnly proclaimed: "The most Blessed Virgin Mary, in the first instant of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege granted by almighty God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the saviour of the human race, was preserved free from all stain of original sin." Let us celebrate the solemnity in a worthy manner and seek her intercession and her blessings on us and our ministry.

We are already in the Advent season and about to celebrate Christmas. It is good to remember that Christmas is not the mere commemoration of the historic birth of Jesus. But it is the celebration of God's greatest gift of love to us here and now. It is a season of connectedness. It celebrates the connectedness of human beings with God and with one another. The crib of Bethlehem manifests to us in a sublime way that God's incarnate love came to us in the form of a helpless little babe. Jesus was born small so that we may not seek to

dominate others. He was born poor so that we can consider him as the only wealth. He was born weak so that we may know the strength of meekness. He was born in the night so that we may believe that He can enlighten every reality. He shared our humanity so that we may share in his Divinity. Christmas reveals not only the mystery of the humankind. For this reason, we are called upon to love God in our neighbor. To go out of ourselves - to the human community - the needy, the poor and the downtrodden because God of love identifies himself with them. If we do not do this, we are in no way better than the Bethlehemites who slammed their doors to Joseph and Mary that first Christmas.

Christmas in essence is an invitation to let our differences disappear. To repair broken bridges and mend strained relationship, to heal the scars and wounds we have inflicted on each other and the world at large. Love harmonizes. Therefore, the idea of harmony is so central to the theme of Christmas. Harmony within self, with our neighbor, in nature among God's creation and ultimately harmony with God. We are currently witnessing an ever-increasing exploitation, plundering, destruction and violence. Against this bleak and dismal picture of the world, the birth of Jesus is an invitation to get rid of our darkness, to move on into the realm of light, to look deep within ourselves to find the spark of the divine. Only this spark of divine in us can discover the God of compassion of love and peace.

The humble of heart, the lowly, and people who are attentive to the inner voice of the conscience like the shepherds can hear the call of God to worship. On Christmas the angels sang "Glory to God and peace to people of goodwill". The people of good will are those who respect life, promote it and defend it wherever it is threatened. They are those who work for the common good of the human community specially that of the marginalized of the society. The peace of Christmas fills the hearts of those who live up the beatitudes of Christ and enjoys the blessedness therein.

Let us keep baby Jesus as center of our hearts, our lives, our congregation, our institutions, our cultures and our world, that we may grow in holiness, communion and compassion. May this Christmas help us to become children of light, of love, of God and then to bring the light of fraternal caring love into the lives of people overwhelmed by darkness.

I wish all the brothers who celebrate their birthday and feast day in this month.

Let us pray for our departed brothers who has gone to eternal bliss this month.


St. Charles High School
